Harry slowly came down from the tree and prodded Raju. "Was the bear talking to you? What did he say?" Harry asked, curious.

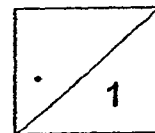

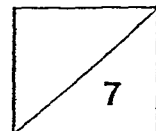

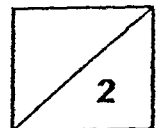
