





Influenza, also known as the flu, is often confused with the common cold. However, influenza is much more serious.

In 1918, the flu pandemic hit the world. More than 50 million people around the world died because of the flu virus. Till now, it is still deadly. It kills about half a million people annually.

People often think that if they are healthy, they do not need the flu jab. They think that the jab will make them sick. Instead, this jab contains dead virus that prevents them from falling sick. The dead virus tricks the body to make antibodies which will protect them from the flu. One might also experience some mild symptoms temporarily after the jab.

Studies show that three out of ten people carry the flu virus. However, they do not display any symptoms. This means that one can spread it to a loved one. The virus also lives more than a day on hard surfaces. Therefore, people should always wash their hands before they eat or touch any part of their faces. The virus changes quickly and often. So, people should take the flu jab every year. The flu jab that they took in 2021 would not protect them in 2022.

As the saying goes, "Prevention is better than cure". There is a lesser chance of the flu virus spreading in the community if more people are vaccinated.


