The pictures, not arranged in sequence, are provided to help you think about this topic. Your composition should be based on one or more of these pictures.

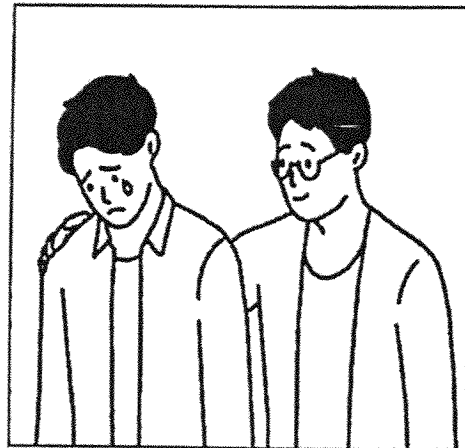
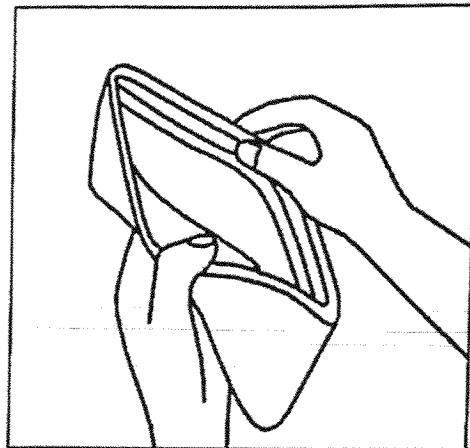
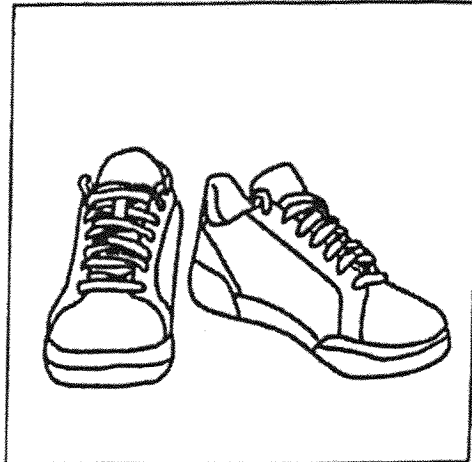
Consider the following points when you plan your composition:
