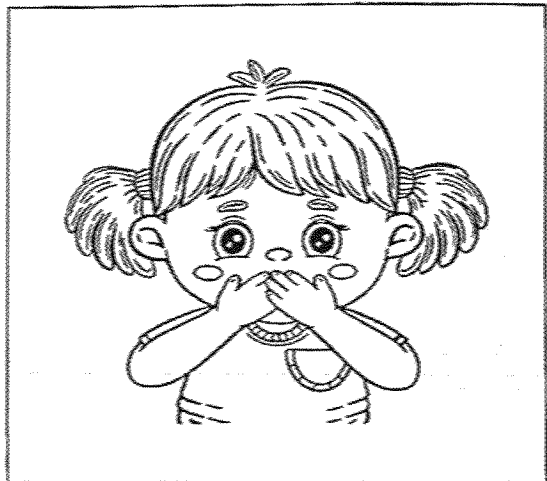
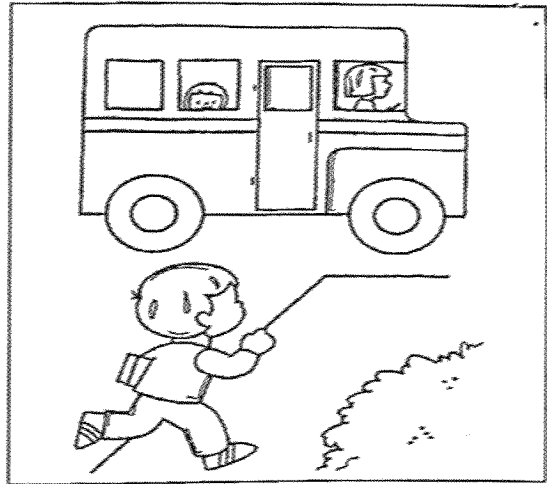
Write a composition of at least 120 words about an incident on the way to school.
