Write a composition of at least 120 words about an **unexpected incident**.

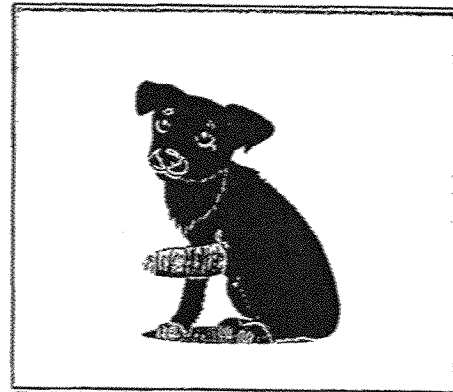
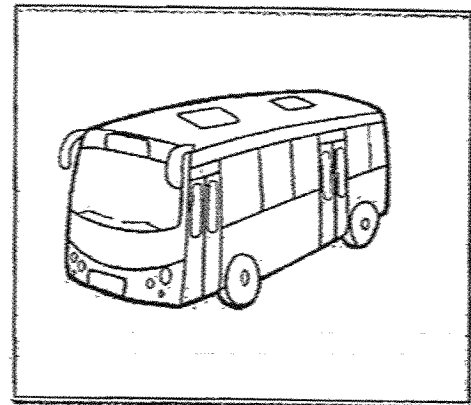
The pictures, not arranged in sequence, are provided to help you think about this topic.
