

Part 1: Situational Writing (14 marks)

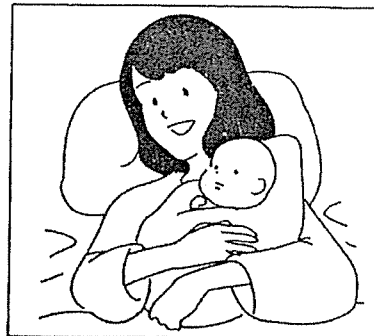
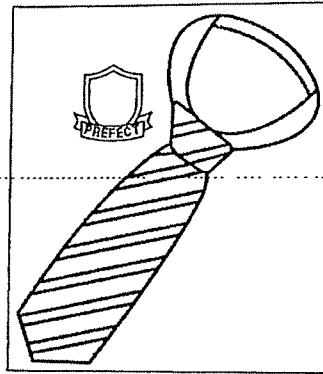
