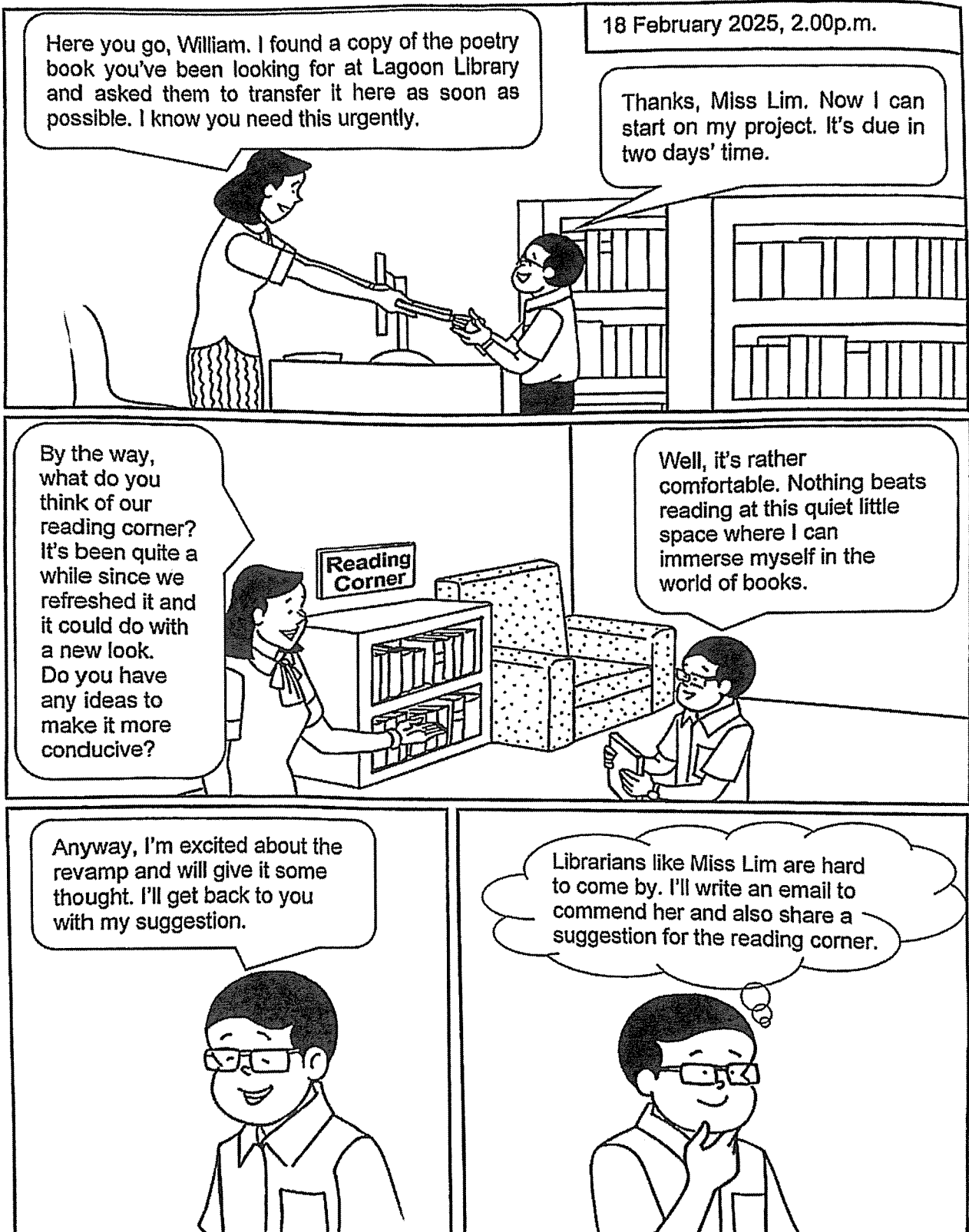

2. Write a composition of at least 150 words about an unexpected delivery.

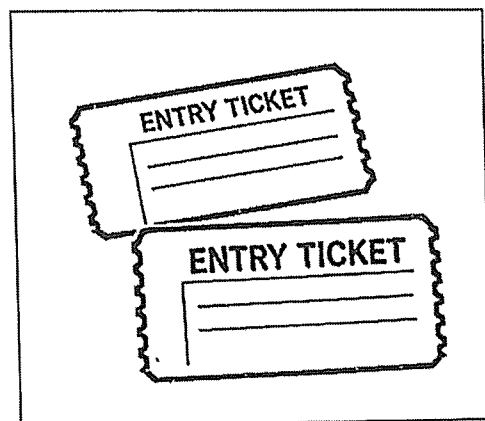
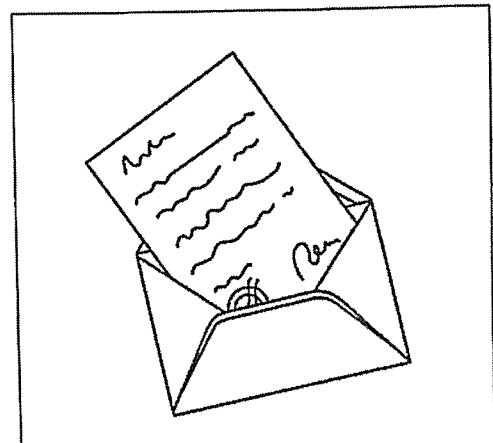
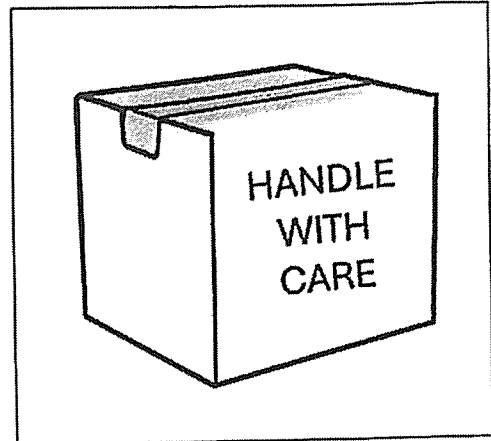
The pictures are provided to help you think about this topic.
